

## How to apply

<b>Enrollment criteria</b>	Conforms to application requirements for overseas Chinese students, and has acquired a certificate of graduation issued by local 6-year Chinese or foreign high school.(Certificate of study is required for applications based on equivalent education level)
<b>Enrollment Method</b>	<p><b>Step1</b> Download the admission brochure from the University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students website, or request for the enrollment forms from the recommending unit.</p> <p><b>Step2</b> Fill out the application data and the priority list online (Go to the homepage for the University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students website <sup>Note</sup> and click on “Country Section”→“Thailand”→“Online Fill Out System”) Note: URL for the University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students: <a href="http://www.overseas.ncu.edu.tw">http://www.overseas.ncu.edu.tw</a></p> <p><b>Step3</b> Select enrollment channel A. Individual application: Fill out the enrollment data and department priority list online, and upload the review data according to the rules from the various departments. Those not admitted will enter the United Distribution channel. B. United Distribution:  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Graduates of the local 6-year high school system shall apply based on one of the four methods including “1. Last 3 years of high school transcripts”; “2. SAT Subject test score”; “3. A Level test score” or “4. IBDP test score”.</li> <li>• Graduates of Chinese schools in Northern Thailand shall apply based on one of the three methods including “1. Comprehensive subject test score”; “2. SAT Subject test score” or “3. IBDP test score”.</li> <li>• Applying with award certificates of International Mathematical Olympiad or Intel International Science and Engineering Fair (after passing the review, the quota will be approved separately with the priority of admission).</li> </ul> </p> <p><b>Step4</b> Hand in the forms: Prepare the required data for the application and send to the overseas unit; Culture Center of Taipei Economic and Cultural Office, Overseas Community Affairs Council or the designated recommending unit prior to the enrollment deadline.</p> <p><b>Step5</b> Announcement of admission result and the collection of distribution notice.</p>
<b>Enrollment Date</b>	Individual application: November and December of every year. United Distribution: February 1 <sup>st</sup> till February 28 <sup>th</sup> of every year.
<b>Enrollment data</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.Application form (in triplicate) and data checklist (1 copy).</li> <li>2.Copy of alien residence permit.</li> <li>3.Copy of graduation certificate (graduating student may enclose a copy of the certificate of attendance or student ID).</li> <li>4.The last 3 years of high school transcripts (those who are applying as graduating student are exempted from enclosing the transcript of that semester if it is unavailable yet).</li> <li>5.Declaration (to be filled out on August 31 only by for those who do not conform to the consecutive residence years stipulated in the brochure).</li> <li>6.Department priority list (form) for United Distribution.</li> <li>7.Applicants using “SAT Subject test score”, “A Level test score” or “IBDP test score” must enclose the original copy of the test or certificate.</li> <li>8.Score Adoption Data Referential Form</li> </ol> <p>※Individual application: The aforementioned 1-8 application data items + uploading review data required by the department applied to for “individual application”.</p> <p>※Applying with awards of International Mathematical Olympiad or Intel International Science and Engineering Fair must enclose the award certificate.</p>
